*Note: Students that apply for Algoma U bursaries for Anishinaabe students may be required to provide documentation to confirm First Nation (status or non-status) or Metis Nation of Ontario affiliation.*

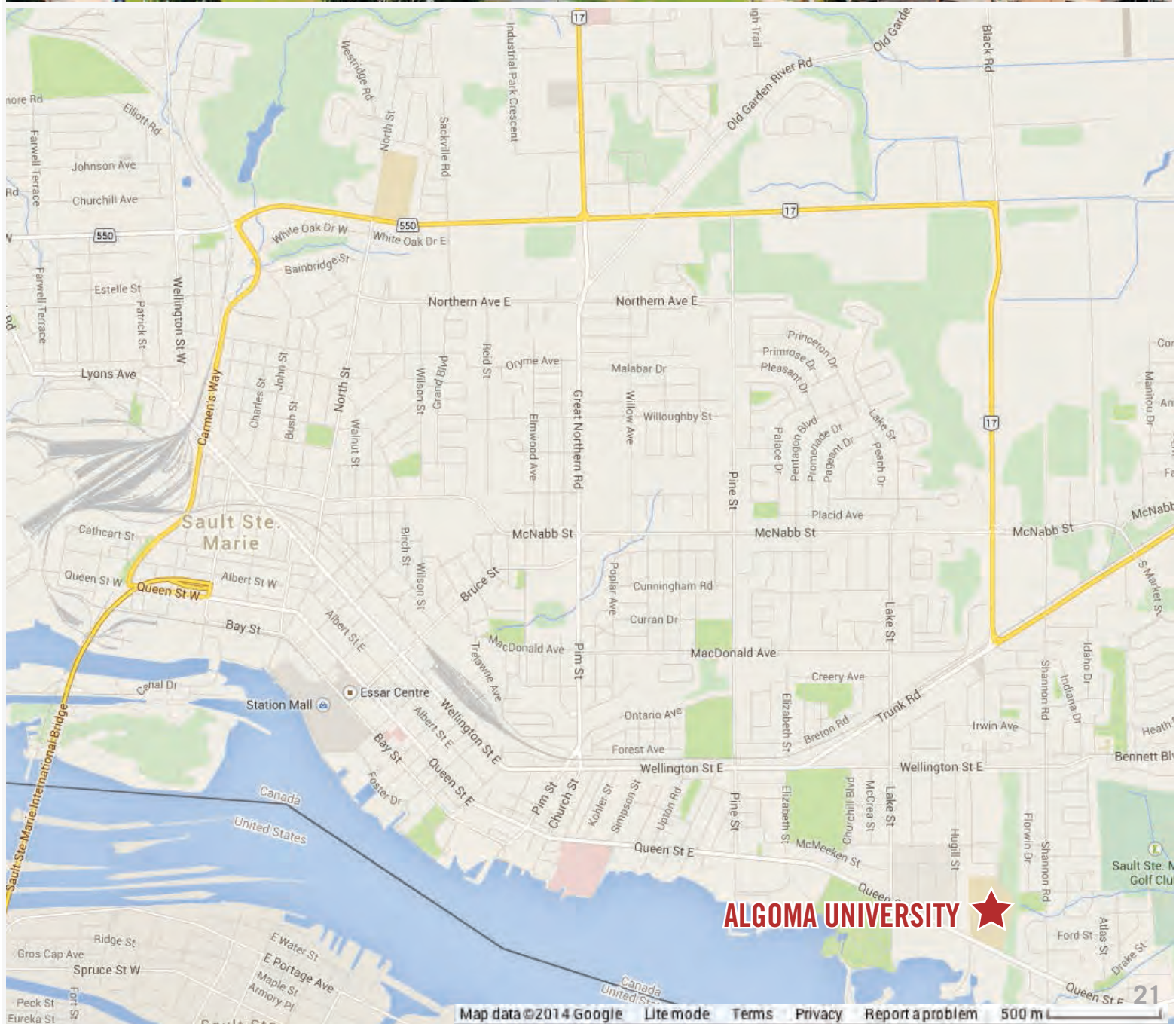

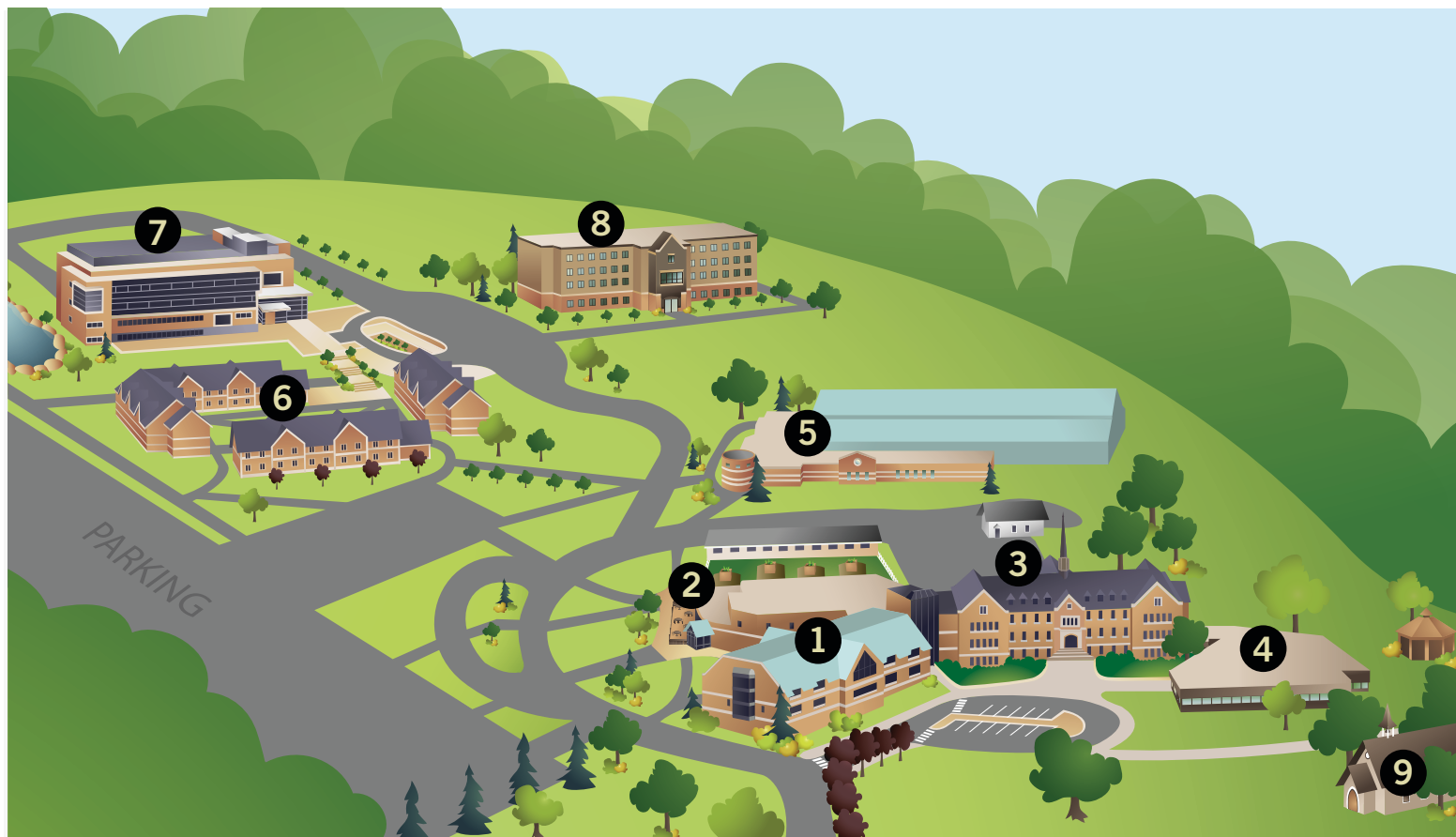
