- When you apply through the Ontario Universities Application Centre (OUAC) or directly to Algoma U; and
- Once you are accepted at Algoma University and have registered for classes, complete the Voluntary Aboriginal Self-Identification on your AU student portal at students.algomau.ca

Students that have self-declared will be added to an email list and receive information about community events, academic workshops, scholarships, bursaries, employment opportunities and cultural activities.

Note: Students that apply for Algoma U bursaries for Anishinaabe students may be required to provide documentation to confirm First Nation (status or non-status) or Metis Nation of Ontario affiliation.


SHINGWAUK KINOOMAAGE GAMIG






