Today, the Ontario Government announced that the Peel region will be moving to [Lockdown](#).

The move to lockdown does permit post-secondary schools in the Peel region to remain open and sustain a safe environment to support virtual learning and in person learning for such disciplines as clinical training or training related to a trade.

To meet our social responsibility to help reduce the spread and with our Algoma University Brampton Community in mind, effective immediately the following changes will be implemented:

- **All** employees will work from home, except for emergency situations
- The computer lab will remain open to students, with a maximum occupancy of five (5) people at a time
- Campus Hours will be reduced to:
 - Monday - Friday: 9am-7pm
 - Saturday - Sunday: Closed

This decision will be closely monitored, and notice will be provided to our internal community when new information is made available.
