Today, the Ontario Government [announced](#) that the Stay-at-Home Order and the shutdown measures are being extended for an additional two weeks in Peel Region, along with Toronto Public Health Region and North Bay-Parry Sound District. As a result, our Brampton Campus will **remain closed until March 8th, 2021**.

All employees will continue working from home except for emergencies. Any employees who require emergency access to the campus are asked to please contact [Yuka Yamada](#), Manager of Brampton Operations. Before coming to campus, you will be required to complete the Health Screening Tool.

The Ontario Government and the Public Health continue to emphasize the importance of staying at home and limiting close contacts to your household, regardless of which level of the Framework you are in.
