Last Friday (March 5), The Ontario Government [announced](#) that the Peel region would be moving from the Stay at Home order and moving to the grey zone (lockdown).

Recognizing the restrictions are very limited and that Peel Public Health is noting that this is a step in the right direction but not a return to normal, we have decided to continue to keep our **Brampton Campus closed** for the time being.
