Algoma University's response to the COVID pandemic continues to evolve as health restrictions ease across the province. We would like to commend our entire community for their tremendous efforts to help keep each other safe throughout the course of the pandemic.

We continue to remain cautiously optimistic and as such, we wish to inform the Algoma University community that **effective June 1, 2022**, the following updates to our COVID protocols will apply:

- Mask Policy the current mask policy will be discontinued until further notice.
   All members of the Algoma University community are encouraged to continue wearing face masks in all indoor settings, especially in areas where distance cannot be maintained and in large crowds.
- 2. Passive Screening remains in effect. This means we ask that if you are feeling unwell, do not come to campus.

Everyone should continue to use the <u>Trackr Safety</u> screening program to passively screen prior to arriving on campus.
