Northern Ontario Business Case Competition

The Northern Ontario Business Case Competition is an annual event with students coming together for an intense one-day event in which they are given an unknown business case, with no access to electronics or the internet. These students are isolated in a breakout room for three hours where they must prepare a comprehensive solution to the business case which is then presented to a panel of judges composed of business professionals. After the presentations, the judges evaluate the teams' solutions and challenge the students with questions or concerns.

Be the Blueprint Conference

Our Student Leadership Conference is an annual event where students and community members are given the opportunity to develop and enhance their personal skills. One of our goals with the conference is to ensure that our students are able to overcome various social barriers and aspire to take on challenges in a new environment. Alongside academic skills, the School of Business & Economics seeks to impart power skills to our students to allow them to grow as individuals.

The Aviation Management

In September 2021, the Algoma University School of Business and Economics commenced the Aviation Management Professional Program (AMP), a four-year BBA degree with an Aviation Management Specialization and the one-year Aviation Management Certificate (AMC). These two programs are designed to meet the growing demand in the aviation industry for both flight and non-flight students and provide aviation professionals looking to upgrade their skills and abilities to the management level with more opportunities for professional development within their current and/or future organization.
