PROGRAM What is it?

The LEAP program is an excellent opportunity for current high school students in the Peel Region to experience university learning while completing their high school diploma.



STUDENTS Who are the key student target groups?

This program seeks to address existing systemic barriers that lead to disproportionalities within education through supporting secondary school students in their grade 11 or grade 12 year.

Students must be on track to complete the Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD) taking U or M level courses and must have completed ENG2D prior to the semester start.



COURSES What are the courses offered?

Students can earn 4 OSSD credits and 2 university courses.

- OSSD Course Options: ENG4U/HSE4M/BBB4M/IDC4U/COP2X
- · Micro-credential in Project Management
