Decisions

Senate By-law Revisions

Revisions to the Senate By-laws were passed to reflect the establishment of the new Faculty of Computer Science.

Curriculum Modifications

The Senate approved the new course proposal for the addition of an elective course within the Faculty of Business and Economics: *ADMN 4047 Cases in Management Science and Analytics*. The Senate approved a program revision proposal to the *First Nation Social Policy and Community Development Certificate* offered by the Faculty of Cross Cultural Studies.

Review Process for Cyclical Program Reviews

The Senate approved that Deans will be directed to determine a formal review process for all current cyclical review programs until a formal determination is made on the roles and responsibilities of Faculty Chairs within these processes.

Changes to Committee Membership

The Senate approved a revised slate of Committee membership.

The Senate further approved the addition of two graduate student members to the Senate I-EDI Committee.

Adjunct Professor Nominations

The Senate approved the adjunct professor nominations for Dr. Kenneth Lee and Dr. Chris MacQuarrie within the Faculty of Science (Biology).

Graduand Lists

The Senate approved graduand lists for degrees, diplomas and graduate certificates to be awarded at Algoma University's Fall 2024 Convocation.

Senate Minutes

The Senate passed the open minutes of the September 13, 2024 meeting of the Senate.
