- **Students who have successfully completed Grade 10 English, ENG2D**
- **Students who may not have considered university**
- **Students needing extra support for university transition**

THE EXPERIENCE ► WHAT TO EXPECT?

- Classes at AlgomaU, Brampton Campus (Mon-Fri, 9:00 AM-2:45 PM with a 45-minute lunch break)
- OSSD courses by PDSB teachers and AU courses by university professors
- Field Trips, tutoring, workshops guest speakers and community activities
- No course or program fees and a Free YMCA Membership
- Students remain registered at their home school for the LEAP semester in order to participate in extra curricular activities, clubs and school events
- Grade 12 students graduate with home school
