

# Admit Type Glossary

When completing your application, you will be asked to select the admit type that best describes your current academic background. The definitions below will help you choose the option that most closely matches your situation.

## **College Graduate**

You have completed or will have completed a diploma or certificate at a college and are applying to start a degree program at the university.

## **College Transfer**

You have studied or are currently studying at a college but will not complete your program prior to attending Algoma University.

## **Early Access Program**

You are a current secondary school student who is interested in taking a university course before graduating from high school.

## **Joint Admissions**

You are applying to a formal partnership program between a college and the university, where you complete part of your studies at each institution as part of a planned pathway.

## **Mature Student**

You have been out of secondary school for at least one year, are a Canadian Citizen or Permanent Resident and do not meet the traditional admission requirements.

## **Non-Degree**

You want to take one or more university courses without enrolling in a full degree program.

## **Readmission**

You were previously enrolled at Algoma University but stopped attending or withdrew, and now want to return to continue your studies.

## **Secondary School Graduate**

You have completed or will have completed secondary/high school and have not attended college or university since graduating.

## **University Graduate**

You have already completed or will have completed a degree and are applying to start another university program.

## **University Transfer**

You have studied at another university but have not completed your degree and want to transfer your courses toward a degree at this university.
