

CAN I REGISTER WITH OUTSTANDING FEES FROM A PRIOR SEMESTER?

No, your account will have a financial hold if there is an outstanding balance past the Financial Hold Assessment Date. While on financial hold, you will be unable to register. To avoid any disruption to your registration, please ensure your balance is paid in full as soon as possible.

Outstanding balances not paid by the applicable payment deadlines are subject to interest charges. Interest is calculated at an annual rate of 1.5%, applied on a monthly basis.

WHAT IS THE PAYMENT DEADLINE FOR 26F & 27W FEES? CAN I PAY MY FEES AFTER THIS DEADLINE?

The chart below outlines the key fee-related deadlines students should be aware of throughout the academic year. Additional details about each deadline, including payment requirements, financial holds and interest assessments, are provided in the sections that follow.

*** New Students: Deposit amount and due date are outlined in your Letter of Offer (LOA). Remaining balance is due based on the deadlines listed above.*

Tuition & Ancillary Fees Payment Deadline:

- Tuition and ancillary fees are due in full by the published deadline
- Student must pay a minimum of **35% of their total tuition and ancillary fees** by this date to maintain their registration
- Any balance remaining after the payment deadline will be subject to a **Late Payment Fee of \$125**
- Students who register on our after this date are required to pay **35% of their total tuition and ancillary fees** at the time of registration to maintain registration and are subject to the **Late Payment Fee of \$125**



Residence Life Payment Deadline:

- All Residence Life fees, including residence fees and meal plans, **must be paid in full** prior to moving into residence.

Financial Hold Assessment Date:

- Students with unpaid balances after the applicable Financial Hold Assessment Date will have a **financial hold** placed on their account
- A financial hold prevents students from:
 - Registering for courses;
 - Receiving official transcripts and other official documents;
 - Making any registration changes
- Financial holds will remain in place until all outstanding balances have been paid in full

Interest Assessment Date:

Students who have not paid their outstanding balance in full by the applicable Interest Assessment Date are considered **in arrears** and will:

- A monthly interest charge of **1.5% (19.56% effective annual rate)** will be applied to outstanding balances starting on the Interest Assessment Date
- This applies to all students, including those receiving **OSAP / Third Party funding** on any unpaid portion of their account

I PAID MY FEES FOR THE UPCOMING TERM, BUT MY ACCOUNT BALANCE IS INDICATING THAT I HAVE OUTSTANDING FEES. WHAT SHOULD I DO?

New Students:

Please review page 3 of your offer letter to determine whether you paid the non-refundable deposit or cleared the balance mentioned in the total academic fees required section of the offer letter. Returning Students:

HOW CAN I OBTAIN MY FEE/PAYMENT RECEIPT AFTER MAKING A PAYMENT?

If you made a payment through Flywire or PayMyTuition you will be emailed the payment confirmation. Receipts provided by Flywire or PayMyTuition are suitable for all immigration purposes and as such we do not issue additional receipts. You are also able to download your account statement via the student portal.

I RECEIVED A FINANCIAL BURSARY FOR MY PROGRAM. WHAT IS THE RELEASE SCHEDULE OF THE BURSARY INSTALLMENTS?

Bursaries, including those outlined in your LOA, are applied directly to your student account prior to the start of the term. Changes to your registration or enrolment status may impact your eligibility and the value of your award.

Students with a credit balance resulting from their bursary may request a refund after the term's final day to make registration changes.

WHAT ARE THE ACCURATE FEES FOR MY UPCOMING SEMESTER?

Your accurate fees will populate once you register for your courses for the upcoming semester. Your fees will change if you make registration changes. Ancillary fees are non-refundable after the first day of class.

WHAT IS THE LAST DAY TO WITHDRAW WITHOUT A FINANCIAL PENALTY FOR RETURNING STUDENTS?

- Ancillary fees are non-refundable after the first day of classes.
- A **non-refundable tuition deposit** applies to all withdrawals after registration:
 - \$200 for domestic students
 - \$1,000 for returning international students





- The last day to receive a tuition refund (less the non-refundable deposit) is September 22, 2026 (14 days after the first day of classes) **26F** and January 19, 2027 for **27W**
